1.0 Preface

I here is a basic question, which will arise in the minds of humans mostly at the late ages, after completing their lustful days on the planet earth. What will happen to us after death? It is wise and essential that every human once attains an age of understanding good and bad of this world to think what will happen to them after their physical life. Many of us not even know that they possess a living spiritual system, which temporarily stays in a perishable physical cover (body). We have an eternal spiritual life after a seasonal physical living. Indeed humans have gone far away from God precisely due to self-pride and acquired knowledge of this world. Thus they refuse to realize or accept the truth that they have not created any new resources on this planet earth, which they make use of in everyday life; and the very basic fact of life i.e. how do they exist on this planet, generation after generation. They try to fit various theories by applying their observatory capabilities (knowledge bases), forgetting that they are observing those things/creatures /planets/stars etc, which are the results of mighty handworks of God Almighty. The people, who do not understand the wisdom of God, would say that there is no God (Psalms 14:1). God being righteous does all His commitments perfectly at every moment; that's why the world survives (We have distinctive seasons: rains, seeding and harvesting; birth and death on this planet earth; Genesis 8:22; Job 36:26-33). Man with his limited observatory knowledge (received from animals/birds/fishes and nature) can never read God's personality. It is God, the father in heavens through His grace and mercy reveals Himself to someone, who He selects as a child for His kingdom (John 3:27; 6:44; Matthew 15:13).

The birth of every human is of two kinds on this planet earth;

• Physical birth (as a child in flesh) through physical parents (father and mother); obligatory/ or mandatory

• Spiritual birth (as a clean spiritual person) through a spiritual father; Righteous choice

In the physical world (within Atmosphere), God has created every creature with a physical mass; whether on the land, or in the sky or in the water, through physical movement they have to show their presence (personality) at different places (appearance).

Physical movement is a dynamic motion; therefore all the creatures physically vibrate (**displace**) to move from one place to another; the day this vibration stops, the creature halts its movement; we may now call that the creature is dead. But let us understand a point here is that this is only a physical death. Vibration that produces energy for a physical body, originates from the heart; that's why God says that heart is the life center of a physical system. Physical system does not develop the needed characters on its own to make it functional; it is the spiritual system that stays inside the physical body produces the necessary characters (**operating commands**). When God created man, He had formed man in His own image and likeness; **the Godly system that every man carries is the spiritual system**; but unfortunately it is naturally in an inactive state or passive state because the human employs it to produce fascinating physical emotions rather than spiritual feelings (**worshiping nature**).

We have to understand that the commands (thoughts) to guide the physical energy have been developed by heart, where the spirit of life dwells. Heart is a signal generator of life; it controls the total physical system in an orderly manner, generating appropriate signals for the functional (characteristic) requirements of different parts of our body. In fact the muscles are amplifiers and the hands/legs are similar to mechanical lever arrangements, using which one can amplify a physical action. When a subsystem (hands, legs or others) draw more energy,

heart needs to respond accordingly; so it goes to a fast beating mode (relatively higher frequency mode). The moment this command signal generator stops functioning, the physical system becomes useless and now the spiritual or characteristic system will have to move out.

Every physical birth on this planet earth is demanded through a corruptive seed (**physical action by a man and a woman produces an embryo**); simply does not qualify to hold the holy characteristic system permanently that comes from heavens. It indicates that some kind of defect has been introduced into humans (man & woman) after their creation.

"Life was created in purity; but sin started with nudity"

Since the children were born to the first parents on the earth after they had committed sin (went against the principles of God), their off-springs became defective. That had brought positively death to the physical system and would continue until the end of this sinful world. That's why the natural life in this world is not God centered but a self-governance based on theories developed by humans through their observations of good and bad.

The God centred physical life was kept in the fruit of life, which humans rejected in order to become like God.

Everyone on this planet earth must surely die; it is God's judgment on the physical system; no one can change it. It is therefore necessary to examine what will happen to us once we move out of this physical body; where will we be rested; how God will receive us; and what kind of life is waiting for all of us. This article makes an attempt to bring out some clarifications on these vital soul saving questions. Praise the Lord; Glory to our Master Jesus Christ.

2.0 Path of Salvation

Is it wise nearly 6000 years after creation to blame Eve and Adam for our misdoings now?

No, God does not like this approach anymore because He has given an alternative path to have eternity. This path is God centered. Friends, we must understand a point that **if anything God offers then it would be eternal but righteous** because God does not like to impose anything on His creatures in unrighteous way. He expects His creatures to choose on their freewill the good and avoid the bad. The reason why He does not impose anything on others is that God is the respecter of His principles not persons; that's why He has made available His love abundantly to all; that is unconditional through His grace and mercy. However to achieve eternity, He expects us to follow some disciplines, which are kept as righteous options for humans. **God wants every one of us to take His proven principles of life so that we can be saved.** Obviously, He expects His creatures to have faith on His principles and in turn on Him. God's principles have eternity as He is eternal; they are in the form of words. So His words are omni potential; they have potential to create, protect and provide the needs. So we need to believe His words to have eternity in a peaceful state.

The alternative plan is known as a path of salvation. It is explicit now why do we need salvation. Salvation means to be saved. What is to be saved in human? We have seen in the preface that every human has a physical body, wherein a Godly spiritual system has been built-in. The built-in system is priceless because it is basically an eternal one and it is in the image and likeness of God or simply the glory of God. It is also well understood that this system can not stay in a defective physical system for a longer period (*Ecclesiastes 8:8*).

So what would happen next?

God has given the path of salvation to save this characteristic system. God is righteous that is right as just; He is love so He cannot hate; He is justice so He cannot do injustice; He is the truth so He can not lie; He is a performer (creator) so He does not want to destroy unless it is warranted; He therefore has kept the plan of salvation in the beginning itself after Adam and Eve became disobedient. In the path of salvation, God chose His only begotten son Jesus Christ as the partner and made him to sacrifice His precious life as the ransom gift for the world of sinners. Jesus Christ died for us; then how could He able to save us. Jesus Christ went to hell on behalf of all of us to destroy the power of a thief, who took the dominion over human life through craftiness; Satan took the power from the first man in the Garden of Eden over earth and its creatures. God raised Jesus Christ the third day and made Him the source of eternal life. Thus, Christ crushed Satan and all the demonic forces to free humans from bondages (sins) and death. Jesus was completely sinless and flawless in everything but God made him cursed on the cross to take all the sins that would originate from the earth and made a righteous covenant with him. Whoever accepts Jesus is Christ (savior of life), will be saved from the eternal death and those who do not accept him will be dumped into the hell of fire.

2.1 Resurrection (Rising from death)

In the Scriptures, we read about rising from the physical death in many places. This was performed by the servants of God through the Spirit of God (*I Kings 17:20-22; II Kings 4:32-36; John 11:42-44; Acts 20:9, 10*). However it is worth understanding that these were miracles to reveal God's glory and mightiness to His believers; but those, who rose from the death, had to pass away from this world

later as per the God's principle. No one can stay forever in a physical body, which they receive from their earthly parents. On the other hand, this section talks about eternal rising.

"Rising to eternal life is defined as 'resurrection"

Every believer of Christ keeps their faith on this process, while taking baptism because the savior has been raised from the death by God Almighty (*Acts 26:8; 1st Corinthians 15:12-23*). Adam was made from the dust of the earth but received the spirit of life directly from God; that's why God planted the fruit of life in the Garden of Eden to maintain the life in a physical mass or body. Since the physical body does not have this blessing after Adam's disobedience, it has become a cursed one (perishable). The day this unfortunate incident happened then onwards the spirit of life will have to come out and rest some where until it gets resurrected for eternity.

As the death has entered through the disobedience of one man (Adam), the spiritual eternity also has been ensured through the obedient son of man (Jesus). **Through Adam every human will get a perishable physical system, which has to be invested in faith on Jesus, believing him as Christ (Son of God)**; who has become the spiritual source of resurrection or simply the source of eternal life (1st Corinthians 15:44-47; Isaiah 57:15). Investing the physical system means to submit our freewill by permitting God's will to control the life. We must realize that every human will be resurrected on the Day of Judgment (God's day); some to receive the eternal life and others to inherit the eternal cursing i.e. eternal death (John 5:28, 29; Daniel 12:2). Unfortunately **the 21st century intelligent generation is least bothered about God's day** because they are much fascinated with 'Lover's day', 'Father's

day', 'Mother's day', 'Friendship day', 'Pet's day', 'Fool's day', etc. Many countries also celebrate 'Independence Day' without understanding that their people are slaves to a sinful life and they are not free.

What will be the state of a dead person before resurrection?

There is a clear distinction made to differentiate souls (spiritual bodies) that leave their physical bodies after the intended stay. God has made His grace and mercy free to all the souls so that they will be saved in the name of His son Jesus Christ. Salvation is real, if a person accepts Jesus Christ as his/or her savior and come to pass in total agreement with the word of God. There is only one name God has recognized to accept the sinners of this world, back into His Kingdom because Jesus had alone paid the fee for this divine mission requirement; the rest of the world had done/have been doing/will do nothing good except committing all the unrighteous acts. As God could not accept any impure sacrifice, He made the purest of pure, His word in flesh as a holy sacrifice. If we do not realize that we are one day will have to meet Jesus Christ then we spend our time on this planet earth without any purpose. Humans have created many religions, faiths, sacrifices, being the representative of God's enemy; the Scriptures however clearly say that Satan knows his destination (*Present: Isaiah 14:9-17*); he will be sealed-off into the hell of fire eternally (*Future: Isaiah 66:24; Revelations 20:10*).

2.2 Facts after death to believers and non-believers

 The children of Christ (believers) after their physical death will not enter the hell; they will be rested in peace as they are rescued and saved from the bondages of Satan and his kingdom of darkness (*Isaiah 57:2*).

- The states (conditions) and the places are different for believers and nonbelievers of Jesus (*Ecclesiastes 3:21; 12:7; 2nd Corinthians 6:14-16*).
- The believers will be in a state of peace; a deep sleep mode; a state of being in paradise (spiritual ecstasy); similar to a state when Adam was kept in a deep sleep mode in the Garden of Eden, which was a paradise on the blessed earth (*Genesis 2:21*). A soul can attain this mode only if God Almighty accepts it in heaven (*Luke 23:46*).
- If we refer to Christ's statement on the cross (*Luke 23:43*), we get more clarity on this deep sleep mode. He told one of the accused, who wanted to receive the salvation at the last moment before his spiritual system leaves out of the physical body that he would be with Him in paradise that day. The true meaning of this is that the spiritual system of the accused would be accepted by God instantly along with Jesus Christ.

Why did God permit this to take place at the last moment?

Remember that the beloved disciples left Jesus; the children of Israel and the gentiles (Romans) cursed and punished Him with utmost sufferings; at that time Jesus was in a state of powerlessness (a total submission to God's judgment) when this accused posed faith in Him; what a matured faith the accused had shown on the savior. God approved him because he became the witness to the sufferings of Jesus Christ; remember, the salvation to this world came into pass on Calvary and the accused was the first one to receive it. Whoever accepts Jesus as Christ will be saved and those who do not will be put into the hell of fire. God Almighty judges anybody with minimum two witnesses and the accused accepted the grace (Jesus) to receive God's mercy at the last moment to become the second witness (*Deuteronomy 17:6*); the first witness was the words Jesus spoke during His ministry (John 12:48).

- Today we enjoy all the privileges and blessings from God Almighty in Jesus name but many of us lead a life that can not witness the love of Christ. We can very well call many of us the "Genetically Modified Christians"; because we like to continue our sinful life even after accepting Christ. It's time to think for a change.
- The non-believers (unclean spirits) will directly be sent to hell, where the demonic forces and their leader Satan have been living.
- Satan indeed effectively employs the images of dead persons (physical figures/images/incidents) to trap their relatives into his fold or dominion; some time to impress upon them that their dead parents or any beloved relatives could do some miracle in their life.
- We must understand a point that once a person is dead then he/or she will have no role on this planet earth that moves on with the movement of physical masses or bodies ('Law of Conservation of Mass'). Remember Satan himself could enter the earth first time only through a physical body (*Genesis 3:1*) and remember before the occurrence of greater flood, the sons of God, who later became demons and supporters of Satan, had entered the earth through physical bodies (*Genesis 6:2*).
- Satan and his demons exploit the images and the names of unclean spirits further to do wicked activities to spoil the children of men. It is Satan's shrewdness that makes such tactics in order to interact with the minds of humans.
- God can not receive any unclean spiritual system (soul+spirit) into heavens; only then allow it to stay in a deserving place; hell is a place meant for the unclean spiritual systems to stay until the resurrection takes place for them to face the God's day.

- Further, these souls will perhaps retain all the emotions that they had developed during their physical stay on the earth; but the characteristic system will be in an inactive state (grounded state: not developing physical emotions and with no spiritual ecstasy) because of not having a spiritual body like Satan and his demons (*Ecclesiastes 9:10; Job 14:12*).
- But on the God's day these unclean spiritual systems will get their spiritual bodies (raised) to face the judgment; therefore they will regain an active spiritual state. Remember God will not give any wisdom and knowledge to unclean spiritual creatures. Therefore, they will have a life without the word of God and the Spirit of God. This is a painful state, which results in broken spiritual state forever (living eternally in darkness). Grinding and weeping is what bible defines as the life style for these people.
- However God will bring with Him (Jesus Christ), those who have fallen asleep in Jesus Christ on the Day of Judgment (*1st Thessalonians 4:13, 14*).
- If God receives a clean spiritual system, then every clean thoughts, images and feelings of that person are retained in heavens (simply fruits of spirit); so he/ or she will be in a deep sleep mode (a state of being in paradise/ spiritual ecstasy); because the believer had posed his/or her faith in Jesus Christ that He would save him/ or her. This is a wonderful arrangement; that's why during our physical stay God wants our spiritual system to be cleansed through His Holy Spirit, the provider of heavenly system (2nd Corinthians 7:1).
- There is indeed no need to store any physical information after physical death because they will become obsolete or useless (*Ecclesiastes 9:5; Job 14:22*); because there will be no physical relations/feelings exist in heavens. That's why Jesus Christ has asked us to save the treasures (only the fruits of love) for ourselves in heavens (*Matthew 6:19, 20*).

• All the physical memories would be filtered by God and only He might provide useful information to any person, if required (*Refer to An Insight into Heaven*© by Bro. D.G.S. Dhinakaran).

The resurrection of believers takes place as follows (1st Thessalonians 4:15-17):

- Those who died will rise first (*reformation:* restructuring).
- Those who are living in physical bodies shall simultaneously be caught up (*transformation:* adaptation) along with the resurrected dead.

(a) Formation or structuring of the human body

Adam was formed from the dust of the earth (his body was made out of earthly substances) and God dressed him with the light (Spirit of God/ Wisdom of God); that's why he did not feel his nudity and could able to perform on behalf of Father God in the Garden of Eden, naming the creatures. Remember that this job really involves a careful examination of the nature of each species (*Genesis 2:7, 19, 20*). The physical body of a man must go back to the ground, according to God's word (*Genesis 3:19*). God chose the earthly substances as the materialistic system for the human design because the creature would be expected to live on the earth to produce the similar natured products (off-springs).

(b) Reformation or restructuring of the human body

In the process of *reformation or restructuring* (*resurrection*), God may use the earthly substances once again (*John 5:28, 29; Daniel 12:2*). However, we must understand here that a dead body once buried into the ground (earth crest) becomes earthly substances (state of dispersion). When God formed Adam, He spoke to Him-self; because He had the image of a human in His mind i.e. God was the source of life and image for Adam and so He employed the spiritual energy (light form) to make a shape out of earthly substances from ground. Similarly He

had the image for the resurrected human system in His mind and thus in that image, God resurrected Jesus Christ from the hell; furthermore He has made Christ as the source of future resurrection (*John 5:21*). Since the resurrected humans will stay forever on the new earth under the new heavens, God Almighty may use the earthly substances to make their bodies; certainly they (Children of Christ) will be dressed with the light like the angels and provided with the wisdom and knowledge of God. The resurrected body may not contain similar flesh and blood like what we have now; therefore it may be called a restructured body (*1st Corinthians 15:50*); remember our savior had shed all the blood on Calvary went as a spiritual person to hell. The food and digestive system of him after resurrection may be of heavenly kind (*Genesis 18:8*).

It is better to recollect our school science on the digestive system of human briefly to appreciate the heavenly system. The human system in flesh must survive through the blood (a liquid form of energy that is circulated throughout the body), which absorbs the energy at molecular level from the digested food particles (energy absorption through molecular decomposition process). The remaining portion will be drained out into the source back (ground). It is a chemical reaction; it is therefore not a process of total consumption of energy; there will be always a residue or dissipation in this process. However, in the heavenly system, it is a total conservation of energy approach followed; that is to burn and transform anything and everything (substances or matters) into the fundamental form of energy (light energy). The substances may be burnt completely at a very high temperature so that an *energy transformation* takes place completely. If we carefully examine the Scriptures then we may find a fact is that God Almighty wanted all the burnt and meal offerings to Him must be burnt completely (Law of Commandments).

This is not applicable to a human, because God does not want a dead body. God has clearly instructed Adam that the earthly principle of conservation of mass must be followed in human design (Genesis 3:19). When we burn a dead person, this principle is grossly violated; Satan is aware of this law. God Almighty has the data of every dead on the earth and where exactly each one has been buried. Every one may be risen from their respective places (buried locations), according to the seniority in their resurrected body. However the spiritual system (eternal life source) would come from the heavens, which becomes active from its inactive deep sleep mode to take the resurrected body.

The non-believers of this Godly principle indeed are the unclean spiritual systems and have not put trust in the resurrection of Jesus Christ during their physical stay (*Matthew 27:62-66*). Therefore automatically become ineligible to live on the new earth, which will be ruled by the King of King and the Prince of Peace, Jesus Christ.

(c) Transformation or adaptation (Rapture)

If we carefully read the Scriptures then we may notice the following facts on *transformation or adaptation* of an earthly personality (physical+spiritual) into a heavenly personality (spiritual):

- Before the greater flood took place, God Almighty had transformed a faithful person (Enoch) with his physical body (alive) like an angelic creature; during the first 2000 years of human history (*Genesis 5:24*).
- After the greater flood and before the birth of Jesus Christ, God Almighty second time had transformed alive another faithful prophet (Elijah) into a heavenly creature (2nd Kings 2:11); this had happened during the next 2000 years of human history.

• Third time God Almighty had performed a wonderful miracle of making Jesus to leave the physical body as a spiritual personality (on the cross) and again gave Him the power (on the third day) to get adapted with His original physical body to become alive in both states (heavenly and earthly). By performing this miracle, God almighty has demonstrated both reformation or restructuring as well as transformation or adaptation.

However, Enoch and Elijah will have to become the witnesses of Jesus Christ on the sinful earth to cover the entire human history; they will be witnessing Jesus as Christ, through whom Jews will also receive salvation (Revelations 11:3-8); but Enoch and Elijah will have to physically die in Jesus, later to get resurrected by Christ. No human will get eternal life without witnessing Jesus as Christ. This principle is equally applicable to Enoch and Elijah. Rapture means transformation into a heavenly creature from the living physical state; the church (born again Christians) has a strong belief on this event (1st Corinthians 15:51, 52). Now we have to understand the principle of God carefully; i.e. why the believers, who will have physical life at the time of rapture, need not face the physical death. The day any human takes baptism (complete immersion in water) in the name of Father God, His son Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit, it logically means the death of a sinful life and gets resurrected in Christ to have a new life, witnessing Jesus as Christ to the world (2nd Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 2:4-7). Also it is worth noticing that no believers will have to visit hell after their death; thus there is no need for the physical life to die but only an adaptation is required.

2.3 Personalities of the resurrected believers

• There will be no difference between male and female; and there exists no family structure (*Matthew 22:30*).

- The new creature will be like an angle (spiritual body: spirit, soul, heart, eyes etc).
- The light is given as dress; thus no physical feelings (Adam and Eve were in this state before committing sin in the Garden of Eden).
- Wisdom and knowledge of God will be the language (*Daniel 12:3*).
- Designation: Selected ones will be made Ministers, Judges and Priests (*Revelations 5:10*); others will be appointed as worship leaders (*Revelations 6:9-11*); rest all will be given the status as worshipers (*Revelations 7:9-16*).

Therefore, it is clear that God Almighty would resurrect every believer of Christ in the order of seniority (earthly stay) and award them according to their spiritual designation, the required spiritual gifts (wisdom and knowledge, and honors). **There will be no physical information or feelings required for this new life.** Physical feelings will be consumed normally during the physical stay by the Spirit of God and the rest will be filtered in heavens. A believer will receive gifts, according to the merit of his/ or her state of life on the earth during the physical stay and the requirements they satisfy for the designation to be awarded by God. Harvesting the souls, preaching the gospel and witnessing Jesus Christ are the deciding factors. Nevertheless seeing God's face in His glory itself is a priceless gift which any body can think of.

Therefore, those who die in Christ, accepting Jesus as their father will receive His identity. Further will have

- Eternal life (Spiritually active state: excited condition),
- Wisdom and knowledge.

And those who refuse to accept Jesus as Christ will retain their own identities.

They will inherit with

- Eternal death (Spiritually in-active state: depressed condition)
- Observatory knowledge gained during their physical stay

3.0 Facts after resurrection

God has appointed and crowned Jesus Christ as the righteous judge to decide the course of action for the world. Today Jesus is the savior, in whom any sinner will be forgiven from his/or her wickedness to receive an eternal life; but if we refuse to accept the truth (Jesus is the Lord), then on the God's day (Judgment day), He will have no preference but to allow such a person, taking their reward (eternal death) that is meant for Satan and his demons.

In a nut-shell:

- Authority of Judgment. Jesus Christ
- Power to resurrect the dead: Jesus Christ
- Source of eternal life: Jesus Christ

Therefore the tongue that does not address Jesus as the Lord will not have eternity in a peaceful state.

What is eternal life and eternal death?

In the Scriptures, we read in many places about the future of human life; **both eternal life and eternal death are spirit centred**; that is related to Godly system in every man and woman. Both will exist forever (eternal) but one with light and the other in outer darkness. We must realize that the physical death would bring end to our physical sufferings (*Romans 6:7*). Remember that the feelings are developed by a spiritual member called, 'soul'.

It means that these feelings will be carried forward to further life.

- Believer's further life: Godly nature (eternal life)
- Non-believer's further life: Satanic nature (eternal death)

Therefore after the righteous judgment, what will be our future?
