

Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him,"

Genesis 2:18

In this spiritual letter, we bring out the facts from the Holy Scriptures the worth of Eve in Adam's life; and the mission God the father had undertaken on the earth. At the end, it will become evident that God's wisdom is beyond our limit to understand. Let the praise and honour is to Father God in Jesus name.



What really made God to think that Adam needed a partner?

Indeed, bible clearly says that Adam was created before Eve and Eve's body was cloned from

Adam.

- ❖ God created Adam as His son in His own image and likeness for a divine mission (**Genesis 1:28**).
- ❖ The mission was to receive children (**worshippers**) like His son Jesus Christ on a paradise earth (**worship center**) from Adam and Eve.
- ❖ Adam therefore was created as a primary source for this divine purpose and Eve as a helper or secondary source (**1st Corinthians 11:7**).
- ❖ God spoke to various sources to create lives in those sources; for example
 - He spoke to Himself to create light and Adam
 - He spoke to earth to grow plants, trees, animals etc
 - He spoke to sky, ocean to create other creatures
- ❖ Hence, God felt that Adam, who was anointed to create new lives on the paradise earth, needed a secondary source, so that when Adam speaks to that source, a new life would be created. The primary source in fact had to deliver the Word of God (**spiritual seed**), which was embedded in the Spirit of life, such that a spiritual system (**soul + spirit + mind + freewill**) would be fused into a physical embryo (flesh) in the secondary source.

The sources being fruitful would multiply in their image and likeness (*Genesis 1:28; Luke 1:35*).

In this way, our father in heavens wanted to create heavenly creatures for the worship ministry as replacement to the rebellious angels under the leadership of Lucifer.

- ❖ God made Adam's flesh out of the dust of the earth; Then He sanctified this flesh by transforming water into blood and breathing His Spirit into the flesh.
- ❖ *Genesis 2:18* says that the Lord God said: *"It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper suitable for him"*.
- ❖ Therefore, it is clear that God decided to create Eve only after He thoroughly examined Adam's nature.
- ❖ To create Eve, God did not make use of the dust of the earth; instead He used the flesh and bone of Adam. **Because Adam was already sanctified by both water and spirit.** Adam was a primary source because he received the blood from water and spirit from God directly. Water is treated equivalently as spirit of eternal life (*1st John 5:8*).

Physical cleaning means baptism in water; Spiritual cleaning symbolizes anointing with Holy Spirit.

- ❖ To create worshipers, Adam and Eve needed to be fruitful (*Galatians 5:22*).
"Now the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control".
- ❖ As God spoke to Virgin Mary, Adam had to speak to Eve to deliver the Word of God and the Spirit of God would have had carried this spiritual seed into Eve's womb, where this eternal seed might have had embedded into an embryo to create a new life. Adam had to decide whether the worshiper was to be in his likeness or like Eve. This is what exactly **being fruitful and multiplying**.
- ❖ Thus, God awarded both Adam and Eve only spiritual feelings (*Genesis 2:25*).

Eve was created as a necessary supporter to Adam for the divine purpose of creating new lives on a paradise earth (*Spiritual Cloning*).

- ❖ Unfortunately, due to her disbelief in God's word and subsequent disobedience; further Adam's non-compliance of the covenant he had with the father of all lives,

both had lost their spiritual cloning potentials and retained only the physical cloning responsibilities (*Genesis 4:1*).

If Eve had **self-control**, then she would have displayed a **gentleness** not lustfulness to show her **faithfulness** to Adam, for his **goodness** in sharing a life with her; if Adam had remembered God's **kindness**, he would have avoided a **long suffering** physical life by keeping trust in God's word to retain God's glory (Spirit) to have **peace** and **joy** in everlasting life for building a generation to worship God with **love**.

What is the role of Eve in the spiritual mission of God almighty?

- ❖ God knew Satan's plan of deceiving humans, who He created as worshipers.
- ❖ So, He created Adam exactly in His image (*1st Corinthians 11:7*), thus Satan could not directly interact with Adam's thought life.
- ❖ Also, God had trained Adam spiritually to read physical creatures like Him (*Genesis 2:19, 20*); Adam knew that Serpent couldn't speak.
- ❖ *1st Corinthians 11:8, 9* read as:
"For man did not come from woman, but woman from man; neither was man created for woman, but woman for man".
- ❖ Eve was expected to convey an evil thought before processing it to Adam (**worship leader**), which would be received in her mind; by this way she had to help Adam to take a righteous decision. **God wanted Adam and Eve to take a collective decision.** That's why God felt that Adam needed a helper to receive the thought developed by Satan; when Lucifer (former arch angel) was found untruthful to Father God, he became Satan (**enemy to God**). Satan wanted to be like God that was his problem. In order to bring this hidden thought out of Satan's mind, God had created two observable systems, namely Adam and Eve. Heavens were observing Satan when he entered earth with his evil plan.
- ❖ Eve (**helper**) was a spiritual soldier to Adam (**master**); Adam (**helper**) was a spiritual soldier to God (**master**).

What is the spiritual war and why these two (Adam and Eve) had to involve in it?

- ❖ Satan, a former worship leader of God, was the father of lies and had developed lots of lustful thoughts (**wicked**) with virtual feelings.
- ❖ God wanted to expose him to heavens (**spiritual worlds**) through earth (**physical world**). So, He had established the principle that no one could enter into the physical world only with a spiritual system.
- ❖ Therefore, Satan being a spiritual creature needed a physical system (**Serpent's image**).
- ❖ **Eve had to receive Satan's thought and convey to Adam; so that Adam would seek God's judgment.** Unfortunately Eve told Satan the eternal truth and made his life easy and her life difficult. In case Eve would not have told the eternal truth and just conveyed Adam about Serpent's ability to speak, everything would have gone in a righteous way. More interaction with the world will bring troubles in our life.
- ❖ We, the children of Adam have to take the first step in the graceful time; that is to accept God's judgment i.e. Jesus as Christ (**Son of God**). Then Jesus will provide the necessary comfort and power to defeat Satan and his evil plans, so that Satan's plans will have no impact on our life.
- ❖ We are the spiritual soldiers of our father Jesus Christ. Hallelujah, glory to God.

Why did Eve fail to hold on her faith in the Word of God?

- ❖ She participated **in a thought process on her freewill**; created images, which were executable commands by the physical system (**James 1:14, 15**); indeed once images are created in a physical system, it would simply execute them. Exactly same thing had happened in her life.
- ❖ She was not given authority to take a decision; because she was not involved in the process of creation of other creatures; Adam worked with God in naming the creatures.
- ❖ She revealed the truth of God to His enemy (**eternal physical life**).
- ❖ She effectively employed the virtual potentials (proud, shrewd), supplied by Satan; as the result, she started reading physical features of other creatures (**Genesis 3:6**).

Is Eve a failure?

- ❖ No, certainly not.
- ❖ Eve had the seed cover for Jesus Christ to come in flesh.

- ❖ Eve did not complaint about Adam and his guidance to learn about God and His faithful covenant; however Adam blamed Eve and the father in heavens who gave him Eve.
- ❖ Eve realized her mistake and worshiped God, when she received Seth (*Genesis 4:25, 26*).
- ❖ God was more disappointed with the behavior of Adam (*Genesis 3:17; Hosea 6:6, 7*).

In the Scriptures, we read about many successful Eves.

- Sarah – supporting faith
- Deborah – prophesying faith
- Ruth – growing faith
- Esther – organizing faith
- Virgin Mary – carrying faith
- Magdalena – witnessing faith



What are the steps to be taken to become a successful Eve?

1st Corinthians 11:11, 12 read as:

“In the Lord, however, woman is not independent of man, nor is man independent of woman. For as woman came from man, so also man is born of woman. But everything comes from God”.

- ❖ Listen to God’s word and honor them (*Luke 1:38*).
- ❖ Obey your father and standby with your husband (*John 2:4, 5*).
- ❖ Fast and pray for the family regularly (*Esther 4:16*).
- ❖ Select a proper job to build the family, if required (*Ruth 2:2*).
- ❖ Provide help & guidance to the children (family), congregation and believers (*Judges 5:7; 1st Corinthians 16:19; 2nd John 1, 2*).

Dear Sisters in Christ, you are fearfully and wonderfully created to build a faithful family; so thank God for His wisdom. Brothers, God loves relationship, so respect your partner. Let all the glory and honor be to God the Father, Son of God and Holy Spirit, Amen.
